

GUIDELINES TO WRITE A LETTER OF MOTIVATION

The letter should include at least the following points:

- Explain why you want to do a Clerkship abroad.
- Explain also the interest you have to chose that type of Clerkship.
- Your expectations from the chosen Clerkship and for living abroad for a while.
- What would you like to do during the Clerkship.
- If you had got any experience doing:
 - any medical practice
 - any work in a laboratory
 - different parallel medical experience
- ...
- The letter must be written in English or in the mother language of the Country you'll visit, or in one of the languages specified in the Exchange Conditions. It is compulsory to typewrite the letter !!

Of course you can include all the information you want but, do not make the letter very long.
